Communion Psalm: Ps. 5, 4 be. 5-6. 7· 8. 12 ab. 12 be. 13



Quoniam ad te orabo, **Domine**, /mane exaudies vocem **meam**.

For to thee will I pray: O Lord, in the morning thou shalt hear my voice.

Mane astabo tibi, et vi-**de**-bo /quoniam non Deus volens iniquitatem tu **es**.

In the morning I will stand before thee, and will see: because thou art not a God that willest iniquity.
